Three of these cards are reproduced in Tonie and Valmai Holt, *I'll be seeing you: World War II through its picture postcards*, Ashbourne : Moorland, 1987 (nos 740, 741 and 742); this title is not available at McMaster University Library.

It states that Odette Garreau has been sentenced to 20 years hard labor.

d) Carbon copy of information obtained from the German archives by the French Police on the pro-German activities of Odette Garreau. 1 1/2 pp. 4to.

Gives all the activities of the spy and informer Odette Garreau.

d) Original photographs, front and profile, (2 copies) of Odette Garreau taken by the central police-station of Nantes on September 7, 1945.
