



FINDING INFORMATION FOR TORONTO IN THE CENSUS OF CANADA 1901 (NOMINAL CENSUS)

To find information for an individual in the Census of Canada 1901, you need to know:
 - the Census District and Sub-District Numbers in which they lived, and
 - the microfilm reel number

If you know these things, go directly to Step 2 on page 2.

If you know only the street address, follow Step 1 to get the District, Sub-District and microfilm reel number.

If you know only the individual's name, use a City Directory first, to get the street address.

Step 1: To get the Census District, Sub-District and microfilm reel number

Use the Toronto City Street Name index

Note the **District Number** and the **Sub-District letter and number**, and the **microfilm reel number** for your street address.

Introduction

The 1901 Census offers a rich source of information about Canada and Canadians at the turn of the 20th Century. Through this research tool you can access digitized images of the original census returns, which record age, nationality, religion, profession, income, education, etc for every single resident of Canada on 31 March 1901.

This tool allows researchers to search by **geographic location only**. As this is not a nominally-indexed database, **it is not searchable by family name**. The digital images within this database are copies of the original microfilm records held by Library and Archives of Canada. The information on these images can be used to prepare family histories, the history of towns and villages, research immigration trends and a great deal more. See what you can discover!
