

## **How to Search for Books on a Topic**

Let's search for books on a topic.

Start at the library homepage and put your search terms in the box.

It's best to use only one or two words. Just keep it very simple.

And then click find.

Here are the results.

Let's take a closer look.

This is the title, the author, and date of publication.

This is the location and call number.

The call number is like the address of the book.

You will need to write it down in order to find the book in the stacks.

Let's look at our results again.

On the right hand side of the page, there is a list of terms that might help make your search more precise.

Perhaps you are looking for resources that a specific author wrote or maybe you would like books written only in this century.

Here are the books on democracy and development that were written in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

There are seventeen. The first one is an ebook.

Just click here to read the book online.

You don't even need to be in the library. You can read it anytime, anywhere.
