German forgery with text and illustrations in black and white taken from genuine issues of this newspaper dropped by the British. The text and illustrations in blue are anti-Semitic commentaries by the Germans and collaborators.

Later they were published separately (see De Luchtpost in this section). All have a small hole in the upper margin which signifies they were dropped by balloon.

Reg Auckland collection. **We add** a document (carbon copy) entitled *Notes on the contents of No.9 as planned by the Sub-editorial Committee at its meeting on Friday, November 12th, 1943* (3 pages folio). Very interesting document on the planning of this issue and the responsibilities of each member of the Committee (**See Box 5, File 1 for carbon copy**).

**No.10.** January 1944. B1. Dropped between 5-6 and 10-11 April 1944. Ex. Reg Auckland collection.

**No.11.** February 1944. B2. Dropped between 15-16 and 30-31 March 1944. **Camouflage cover** entitled *V.N.V. Vérité et Morale. Recueil de vingt-cinq discours radiophoniques*. The back wrapper contains a list of recommended publications totally satirical. On the reverse of the wrappers, a text on camouflage and its aims. Ex. Reg Auckland collection.

**No.12.** March 1944. B3. Dropped between 27-28 April and 9-10 May 1944. **Copy with camouflage covers** with the satirical title *La Guerre en dentelles par Léon-Marie-Joseph-Ignace De Grelle. Éditions La Faucille*. The back wrapper imitates the well-known symbol of Larousse but with the motto *Je sème qui m'aime*. Ex. Reg Auckland collection.

**Without number.** D.9. 4 pp. 8vo . Dropped between 14-15 December 1944 and 12-13 January 1945. On the bombing by Allied planes of German headquarters. AAL p. 7. Ex. Reg Auckland collection. 215 x 135.

According to an article published in the *Falling Leaf* (No. 89 p.62), this periodical was prepared in England and was meant to be introduced into Denmark either through Sweden, or air-dropped or dropped in arms containers. According to the same article, there were 13 issues published. They are printed on bible paper and in 4to format. 165 x 115.

B.N. 182. The most well-known and popular newspaper dropped over France. Except for issue No.1, all issues have 4 pages. Issues in the 8vo format measure 210-215 x 130-135mm while issues in the 4to format measure 265-270 x 215.
